

## **World History: The Renaissance Part 1 with Barry Torch**

## Overview:

World History activities are a chance for senior care residents to learn about historical movements and cultures that interest them. This activity is led by Historian, Barry Torch, who shares fundamental knowledge about The Renaissance in Italy. Part 1 defines The Renaissance and what good came out of it including art, architecture, and literature. If participants find this particularly interesting, they may also enjoy Part 2. which explores the darker side of the Renaissance.

Targets: cognitive stimulation, socialization, self-expression, communication.
