



## **Name That Tune: Friendship Theme with David Macintosh**

### **Overview:**

'Name That Tune' is an activity for senior care residents who enjoy music, games, and trivia. Each episode of 'Name That Tune' will have a different theme for which to base discussion. This activity can be used by activity professionals for either group or individual programs.

Before each song is played in full, David will provide viewers with a few hints to help them guess what song is about to be played!

**Targets:** cognitive stimulation, socialization, self-expression, communication.

### **Materials:**

- ❑ **Images:** Printing headshots of the musicians of songs used in this episode may further enhance the overall experience. Singers' names can be found below.
- ❑ **Discussion Questions:** You may want to prepare a few discussion questions to follow each song. Suggestions can be found below.

**Making it Meaningful:** \*Note: Feel free to pause video when David is providing hints, to give viewers longer periods of time to name that tune!

You can make this activity meaningful by providing opportunities for discussion around the theme of 'Friendship'. You can also help to encourage singing and even gentle movement to music throughout the recording.

**Sample discussion questions:**

- “Who have been your closest friends throughout your life?”
- “What does being a good friend mean to you?”
- “Who has stood by you no matter what?”
- “Who would you help in their time of need?”
- “What have you enjoyed doing with your friends? I.e., going on walks, dancing, watching movies.”
